CONDITIONAL SETTLEMENT – ASHLEY SERVICES GROUP LIMITED CLASS ACTION

Summary

• Further to the announcement made on 24 December 2018, IMF announces the settlement of the securities class action against Ashley Services Group Limited (ASH) pursuant to a binding settlement deed, conditional on final approval by the Court.

Conditional Settlement – Ashley Services Group Limited Class Action

Further to the announcement made on 24 December 2018 that an in-principle settlement of the securities class action against ASH had been reached, IMF Bentham Limited (**IMF**) announces that the in-principle agreement is now subject to a binding deed of settlement signed by the parties.

The deed of settlement is subject to various customary conditions, including final approval by the Court.

IMF will provide further information in relation to this case, including the final revenue and profit figures, upon approval of the settlement by the Court. The terms of the settlement are otherwise confidential.

This investment is part of IMF's on-balance sheet portfolio.
